Singing in Worship at Morialta UC

Since our return to gathered Worship on 16th August this year the congregation has refrained from singing in response to ongoing concerns for our COVID vulnerable community.

After much deliberation at our last meeting, Church Council made the decision to re-commence congregational singing from 8th November. We will still remain seated during the singing and be encouraged to use low to moderate levels of volume.

Of course, this decision was not taken lightly. Church Council recognises the range of views held by members of our community, but, based on advice available through State and Synod sources, Church Council considered the risk of contracting COVID-19 through this change in practice to be acceptable.

Morialta UC's COVID Protocols remain in place. People are reminded to stay home if unwell, to register their attendance, use appropriate hand hygiene and maintain physical distancing during their participation in events at Chapel Street.

Church Council will continue to monitor the situation, around COVID-19, as it applies in South Australia and will vary this and other decisions as required in response to any elevated risk.
