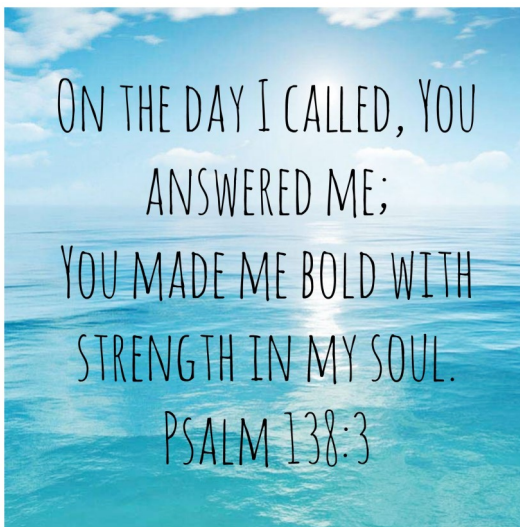

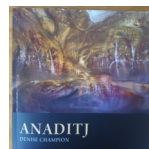
Last Sunday was Reconciliation Sunday of Reconciliation Week.

We will commence reading "It's Time – Challenge to the DOCTRINE of the FAITH" by Michael Morwood. Morwood maintains that doctrine is used as a controlling mechanism. The insistence that doctrine is certain, unchangeable knowledge does not stand up to reasonable, open, scholarly examination. 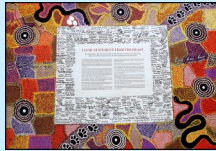
