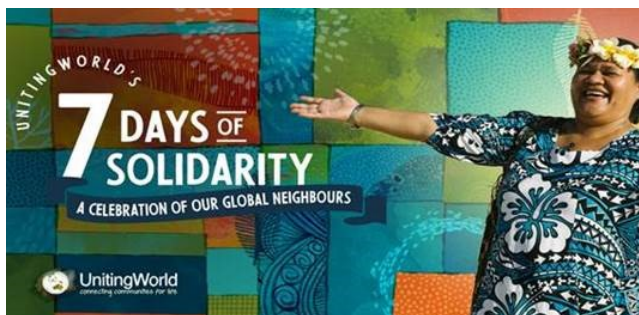

## Rev. Bob Hutchinson's Leave

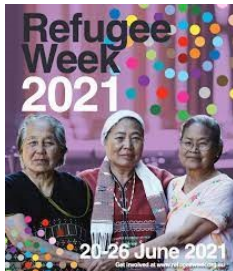
Bob is on leave until 5 July.
