SEMINARY OF THE 3RD AGE

“When Worship is with the Unchurched”

The Effective Living Centre,
26 King William Road, Wayville
Thursday 27th March at 7.00 pm

How does worship best happen when the participants are either totally unfamiliar with the essence of Christianity or have been alienated from the church, usually due to judgmentalism? Jonathan reflects on his ministry in the 90's at Bondi Beach with the “Chapel By The Sea's” ministry with people who were homeless, unemployed, suffered addictions, had mental health issues or were just lost – often in more ways than one. The Sunday evening service provided space for grieving, healing and empowerment with the aim of sharing the gospel of unconditional acceptance. Jonathan also taught a course at the United Theological College known as “Liturgies for the Unchurched”.
