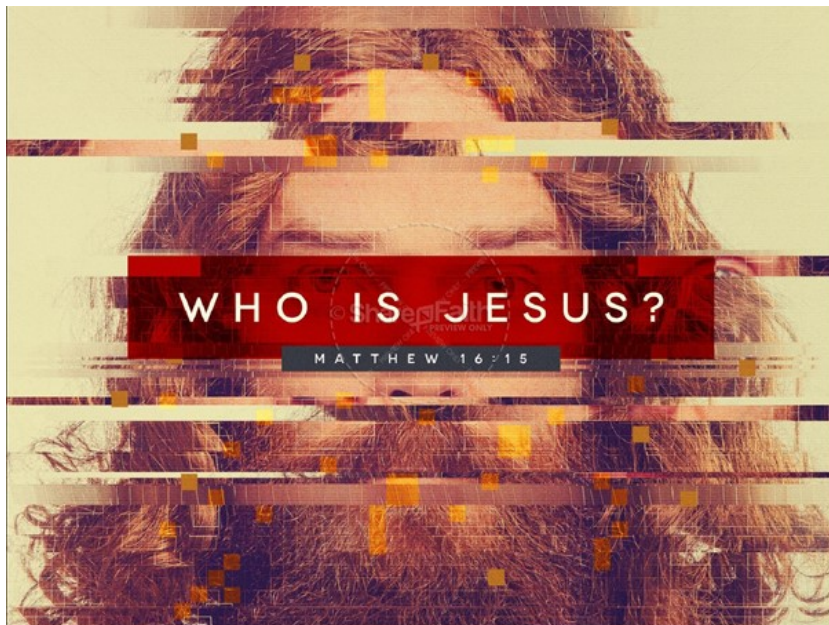

DIRECT LINK TO LIVE ONLINE WORSHIP

We have identified the link problem from last week and have put in place a process that should prevent it in the future.

Here is the YouTube Direct link for our Live Streamed Worship service for 23 August 2020.

If you access the link before 9:30am Sunday you will see a static picture with a timer countdown to the start time of the stream. At 9:30am that will change to a live video stream of our 9:30am worship service.

Joining after 9:30am and before the end of the service you will default to the current time in the service, but you are able to manually start the playback from the beginning or any time up to real time.

If you join after the end of the service you will start at the beginning of the service just like any other YouTube video. The service will remain available well into the future. John Secombe
