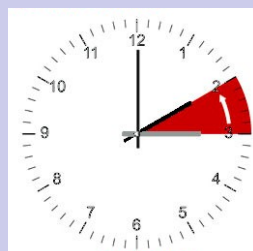
As in the past, Dawoodi Bohras will use our church building during the week and will return the furniture etc back to its usual state for us each Sunday.
