We drive north out of the Grampians to Stawell to visit Caspers World in Miniature and the Sisters Rocks nearby.

After lunch in Stawell we travel to St. Arnaud to visit the Bible Museum with Bibles, stamps and tapestries and a Butterfly Garden.



Pebble Church will be our last site for the day before we return to Halls Gap for dinner and time to prepare for the departure next day.


