## **Discussion**

1. We need to compare the outcome to the figures approved at the March meeting of the congregation as projections to justify our ability to fund a full-time minister into the future.

This indicates that a 3-year cycle for conducting programs such as Mission-Possible! is insufficient and that alternative approaches need to be considered as a matter of some urgency.

- \*An additional issue is that the 'Other committed giving' listed above will come in the loose plate, meaning that our figures for that form of giving will also need careful monitoring.
- 2. The next issue is devising the most effective way to help ensure that promised amounts are actually received, especially from envelopes. Church Council proposes:

That the Finance OMT monitor and review receipts on a monthly basis and prepare

- an item for the newssheet once a month listing promised and received amounts for eGive/EFT, envelopes and open plate giving; and
- an annual report on giving for consideration and relevant action by the mid-year meetings of Church Council and the Congregation.
