## **Reconciliation Sunday**

In November 2006 the SA Presbytery recognised the first Sunday in Reconciliation Week as Reconciliation Sunday. Reconciliation Week begins the day after Sorry Day (May 26th), includes the anniversary of the 1967 referendum (May 27th) and finishes on June 3rd, sometimes known as 'Mabo Day', the anniversary of the High Court's 1992 Mabo judgement which was a major landmark in the recognition of Indigenous land rights in Australia. It also recognizes the covenant relationship with the UAICC (Uniting Aboriginal and Islander Christian Congress) of the Uniting Church in Australia.

Reconciliation Week is a time to build mutually respectful relationships between Indigenous and non-Indigenous Australians. Achieving reconciliation involves raising awareness and knowledge of Indigenous history and culture, changing attitudes that are often based on myths and misunderstandings, and encouraging action.
