

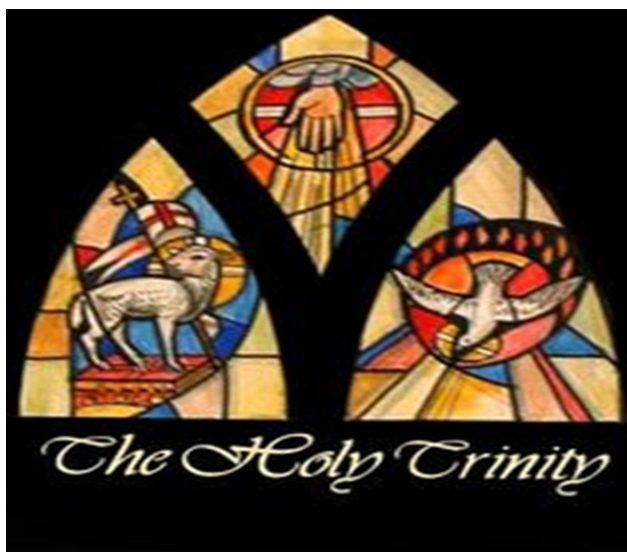

Over time some of us have lost or misplaced our name tags. As part of welcoming our new minister and her family, it would be good to re-start wearing them.

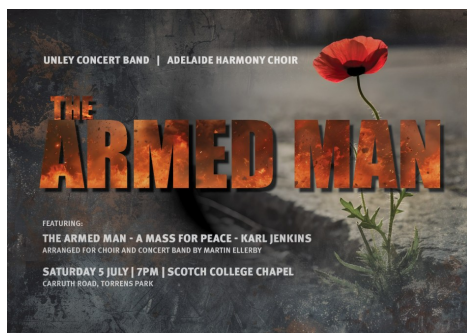


