



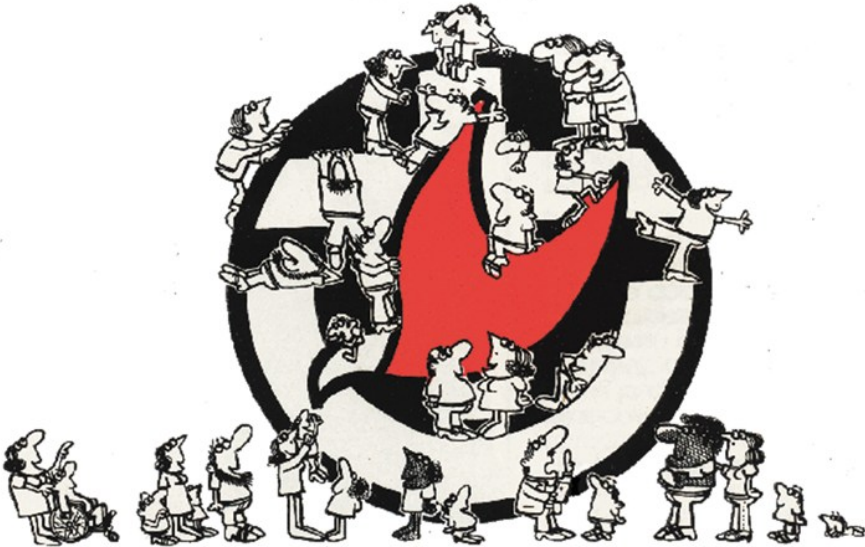


## Gateways
