Mary MacKillop Mass Cantabile Singers

Join the Cantabile Singers for a moving performance of Mary MacKillop Mass for choir and orchestra, composed by Nicholas Buc in honour of Australia's first saint.

First premiered in Adelaide by the Cantabile Singers in 2016 to a standing ovation, this remarkable work was written in 2009 to mark the centenary of Mary MacKillop's death. The performance will feature a full orchestra and a 50-voice choir, with Emma Borgas (soprano, Adelaide Chamber Singers) and Jeremy Tatchell (baritone, State Opera) as soloists, conducted by Denise Rothall.

St Ignatius Church holds special significance in Mary MacKillop's story — it was here she sought refuge in 1871 following her excommunication.
