- But what is the Fossil Fuel Treaty?
- The treaty initiative is a global effort to foster international cooperation
  - to accelerate a transition to renewable energy,
  - end the expansion of coal, oil and gas, and
  - equitably phase out existing production to address the climate crisis.
- The Treaty is not an organisation, **it's a big, bold idea** –
  - matching the scale of the crisis we face
  - backed by a growing global network of governments, civil society organisations, academics, scientists, youth activists, health professionals, faith institutions, Indigenous peoples and hundreds of thousands of other citizens globally.
- Nations states that have signed the treaty include Vanuatu, Fiji, Tuvalu, Solomon Islands, Tonga, Niue, Timor-Leste, Antigua and Barbuda, Palau, Colombia, Samoa, Nauru, and Republic of Marshall Islands, as well as WHO and the European Parliament.
